We apologize for the delay in getting back to your February 1 letter, regarding your invitation to meet in London and discuss matters related to block 135 in Peru.

As you may know, the Company has a new management and post evaluations of current opportunities, it has made the decision to relinquish its exploration rights in Block 135 and return the block to Perupetro effective immediately. To date legal processes are underway.

That being said, we wish to reiterate the Company's commitment to conduct its operations under the highest sustainability and human rights guidelines, avoiding damages to cultures and their surroundings; a value promise we feel remains intact.
